Since then he is developing freelance works - often in collaboration with other artists - for theatre, film and exhibitions. As a guest-teacher he has been working a.o. for Laban Centre London, P.A.R.T.S. Brussels and Ohio State University. In November 2012 he has been appointed Artistic Director of the HZT Berlin.
